ZONED IN: Hampton Roads is HousingForward Virginia's comprehensive and experiential zoning education initiative that seeks to help local leaders and industry professionals better understand zoning ordinances in the Hampton Roads region, and the way they impact housing affordability, racial equity, and the wide range of cross-sector intersections, such as transportation, health, and economic development.

Virginia Zoning Atlas

This initiative presents a unique opportunity to join other states in an effort to compile the National Zoning Atlas. With a statewide zoning atlas, we can better visualize the ways zoning constrains housing and development, while also enabling us to make better cross-jurisdictional comparisons. Beginning this work in Hampton Roads with educational partners will kickstart our efforts to assemble a statewide zoning atlas. It also provide Hampton Roads with a tool to explore the ways in which zoning challenges community goals.

- Zoning dictates the ability to build and then sell diverse types of housing to meet the needs of your clients or local residents.



- Zoning can restrict density and impede much needed housing supply, preventing localities from attracting a diverse workforce.



- Zoning can decrease affordability by imposing strict requirements on builders and developers.



- Zoning can contribute to sprawling development that increases traffic congestion and further isolates communities from opportunity.



- Zoning can help address issues related to climate resiliency and environmental sustainability.

Goals

- Develop plain-language educational materials that explain the components and impacts of zoning ordinances using contextual examples from respective communities.
- Lead local events across Hampton Roads to begin (or build on) discussions about the connections between zoning regulations, racial disparities, and housing affordability.
- Teach local and regional leaders effective messaging techniques to have productive conversations about zoning reform in their own communities.
- Assist leaders with the identification and development of policy solutions to expand housing opportunity and racial equity through land use reform.
- Promote greater regional collaboration on land use decisions.
- Create a replicable process for expanding to other regions of Virginia
